Deadline: May 13 by 20:00 (8:00 PM).

Late Registration: Accepted until May 16 at 11:30 AM.

Fee: €50 per race.

Payment: Provide a receipt of payment or pay in cash at the race office.

Timing & Transponders

The races use electronic timing.

Transponders: Every participant must use a **MyLaps (Red ProFlex)** transponder.

Number Entry: Provide your transponder number during registration on StreamzSports.

Rental: If you do not own a transponder, you can rent one via StreamzSports for **€7.50 per race**.

Pickup/Return: Rental chips must be picked up by the Team Manager (or designated person) at the Pyöräkrossiparkki race office on Saturday, May 16, between 11:15–11:45 AM. Chips must be returned collectively by team after Sunday's races.

Balance Bike Race (Potkupyörä)

A separate start for balance bikes will be held.

Registration: No pre-registration required. Please arrive 15 minutes before the start.

Format: This is a fun-oriented race starting from the last bump of the third straight to the finish line. Prize ceremony will take place immediately after the finish.

Additional Information

Open Practice: Friday, May 15, from 17:00 to 20:00. Note: Depending on weather, track maintenance may be ongoing; the track may only be partially open. **No first aid on-site during Friday practice.**

Catering & Flea Market: A cafe will be open serving hot and cold drinks, alongside a race restaurant serving hot food. A self-service **BMX Flea Market** will be available; sellers should price their own items and payments are made directly to the seller via MobilePay.

General: Parking is located near the track. Parking inside the race area is strictly for permit holders only (one car per team). Team tents can be set up on Saturday morning. First aid will be on-site during Saturday and Sunday races.
